Scope of delivery

Devices according to enclosed delivery note.

Intended use

The manufacturer's radio systems are approved for general remote control applications (switching and control applications) without safety relevance.

Where certain safety requirements are required, they must be implemented by means of subordinate measures with approved equipment.

Safety instructions



Before connecting, using and operating the device, please read the device-specific instructions carefully!

The devices may only be used as described in the device-specific instructions. They may only be used undamaged and under the specified environmental conditions.

Installation and maintenance instructions

The housings may only be opened to connect the power supply and control cables or to change the battery. No other user-serviceable components are included. Further actions/changes require the consent of the manufacturer.

The electrical installation may only be carried out by an authorized electrician who has become familiar with the respective operating instructions.

All work on electrical systems may only be carried out by a qualified electrician or under their quidance or supervision.

Observe the applicable laws, standards and (safety) regulations as well as the manufacturers' instructions for the devices to be controlled! Let

devices without function check by the manufacturer! Do not make any unauthorized changes or modifications to the device!

Function

The function is described in the device-specific instructions.

Commissioning

The radio system is generally configured and delivered fully functional. Individual components may still have to be installed and connected to an external power supply. You will find corresponding notes in the device-specific instructions.



Make sure that no external voltage is present while the devices are being installed and connected.

Transport

Ensure that the devices are adequately protected against vibrations, moisture, dust and electrostatic discharges during transport or returns.

Storage

- do not store outdoors
- store dry and dust-free
- protect from direct sunlight
- do not expose to aggressive media
- avoid mechanical vibrations or shocks

Troubleshooting

- replace the battery(s); check the polarity and the exact type of battery and the correct voltage
- check the power supply
- check the function of radio receivers with additional radio transmitters (if available)
- check the function of radio transmitters with other radio receivers (if available)
- reduce the distance between radio transmitter and radio receiver
- check if other radio applications that use the same frequency range are operated nearby

Battery replacement

Make sure you are not electrostatically charged or take appropriate ESD protection measures.

Only use batteries of the same type and voltage. Observe the polarity of the battery(s).

Warranty

Within the statutory warranty period, defects of the device which are

Disposal
